### **ONLINE COURSE EVALUATION AND CERTIFICATION**

1. Please log on to our website at [www.bwrtsa.co.za](http://www.bwrtsa.co.za) and click on the **ONLINE COURSE EVALUATION** tab. The password needed is **L1thium79**. Once you have completed the online course evaluation your CPD certificates will be emailed to you by **BWRT South Africa**.
2. Your names will be submitted to the Institute of BrainWorking Recursive Therapy UK, and you will be added to their database. You will then receive your BWRT certificate from the Institute.
